**Description:** Applicants to the Early Childhood Education program must have: An undergraduate GPA of at least 2.5

This is a TSAP agreement plan. Transfer Single Articulation Pathway (TSAP) programs, are degree paths which enable students to transfer to IUPUI with junior status. Guarantees only apply to students with continual enrollment throughout their associates and baccalaureate degree academic careers, not including summers, and completion of the TSAP associates degree within seven years of matriculation at Ivy Tech or Vincennes.

**Citical Courses:** Courses that students should complete by specific points during their degree or certificate program.

Milestones: Conditions or activities that students should complete by specific points during their degree or certificate program.

Completing a critical course or milestone by the associated term is considered crucial to on-time graduation.
