**Description:** It is expected that students complete 30 credit hours of coursework per year. If fewer than 30 credits are completed successfully during the Fall or Spring semesters, or if developmental (non-credit) courses must be taken as prerequisites to required courses (e.g., Math 00100), students are expected to enroll in coursework during the Summer terms to get back on track for an on-time graduation.

Please note: a minimum cumulative GPA of a 2.5 or higher is required to remain in good standing within the School of Education.


