Description: Each discipline in the secondary program (English, World Languages, Mathematics, and Social Studies) requires a unique and highly prescribed program of study. In all areas of these programs, the courses are carefully selected to prepare students to meet the rigorous content and teaching standards required for a middle school and high school teaching license in the discipline.

Completing a critical course or milestone by the associated term is considered crucial to on-time graduation.
